Please write a 2000 to 3000-word (eight to twelve double-spaced pages) paper on the following topic.

In Lecture Twenty-Seven I discuss a suggested way of structuring this second paper. The exact details of my suggestion are not required, but at the very least your paper needs to address the following points. Explain the “law and economics” view of tort law (Coase, Calabresi, and/or Posner). Explain the “corrective justice” view of tort law (Epstein, Fletcher, and/or Coleman). Explain the “secular natural law” view of tort law (Johnson). Which theory best explains what we know about torts? Justify your assessment.
